Attention AMHA Members:

Rep Tryout Schedule - For those trying out for Rep Hockey this season, the Rep Tryout schedules have been posted on each the Division pages of www.abbotsfordminorhockey.ca. Currently the schedule has been posted. Details of tryout groups will be posted online by end of day August 13, 2017.

*** Please note this schedule is subject to change without notification. Any and all changes will occur on the webpage only. It is strongly recommended you check back to the website regularly in case of any changes.

Rep Tryout Volunteers Sign up - The AMHA requires volunteers for Registration, Bench coach, and HCSP during tryouts. A signup form will be made available on our website on August 13, 2017 when the player groupings are made.

EPact - Please ensure your child has been registered with the Epact prior to Rep Tryouts. Your child will not be allowed to participate in any on-ice session prior to the Epact Account being completed.

Mandatory Rep Parent Meeting - This season it will be mandatory for all Rep Hockey families to have a minimum of one (1) parent/guardian attend a Rep Parent Meeting. The meetings will be held during the WHL Combine portion of Rep tryouts. Parents/Guardians are to attend this session while their child is on the ice for the Combine Testing.

*** In the event a parent/guardian does not attend this meeting, their child will automatically be removed from Rep Tryouts and placed in the Recreational Hockey Division.

Signed Codes of Conduct - Upon registering on Day 1 of the Rep Tryouts during the WHL Combine, all Parents will be required to submit a signed copy of the **Parent/Supporter Code of Conduct**, and all Players a signed copy of the **Player Code of Conduct**. Please print and bring these with you to tryout registration. You will not be assigned a jersey without submitting these two documents.
