



Supplemental Rules

August 25, 2016

- All participating associations will strive for parity between their own teams in each division. Teams should be balanced as equally as possible
- The league will be a “Fair Play” league. Equal ice time for all players
- Each association will provide one Governor.
- Governors will be appointed to each division at the start of each season
- Suspensions will be reported to the Governor of the appropriate division.
- All game ejections / Write Ups will be sent to Hockey Alberta for discipline.
- A Discipline Committee will be formed consisting of the Governors from each division to deal with supplemental discipline.
- Team managers will enter game scores within 5 days of the game. Individual stats will not be tracked
- All game sheets will be sent to the Governor
- Games must be cancelled 72 hours prior to the scheduled start of the game or the cancelling team may incur the cost of the referees and or the ice.
- Rescheduling games are the sole responsibility of the team that cancelled the game
- Zero tolerance for abuse of officials for parents, coaches and players
- 3 minor penalties in a single game will result in the player being ejected from the game. **This is the coach’s responsibility to ensure the player leaves the ice.**
 - **Coaches who do not enforce the 3 penalty rule by making the offending player leave the ice surface will be subject to supplemental discipline.**
 - 3 penalty rule will not apply to the Novice division
 - NOTE: A double minor penalty is considered 1 penalty. 2 separate penalties called on a player during the same stoppage of play is considered 2 penalties (example: 4 minute hit to the head penalty is considered 1 penalty but a 2 minute hooking penalty and a 2 minute unsportsmanlike penalty called on the same player during the same stoppage of play is considered 2 penalties)
 - A player who receives a 3rd penalty must immediately leave the ice and another player who was on the ice must serve the penalty.
- As per Hockey Alberta rules all affiliates and over age players must be identified on the game sheet prior to the start of the game.
