

APPENDIX: JUNIORS PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIP (Men and Women)

See below for competition specific details. All other rules and details contained in the main body of the Competitors Guide apply to this competition.

Juniors specific notes:

1. All games are 10 ends and are timed.
2. Thinking time is 38 minutes, extra ends are 4 minutes 30 seconds
3. A minimum of 5 ends must be played in round robin games and 6 ends in playoffs
4. Each team MUST have a coach
5. Teams will draw for hammer (LSD) in pre-game practice
6. Playoffs – after round robin, the first (1st) place team will advance to the finals. The second (2nd) and third (3rd) place teams play in a semi-final with the winner advancing to the finals. (see Playoffs section for complete details)
