

APPENDIX: MASTERS PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIP (Men and Women)

See below for competition specific details. All other rules and details contained in the main body of the Competitor's Guide apply to this competition.

1. Format is an 8 Team round robin (unless otherwise indicated)
2. Games are 8 ends
3. Games are not timed and there is no mid game break
4. Teams are permitted two (2) time outs per 8 end game; 60 seconds meeting time or 90 seconds with travel time – Chief Umpire will advise
5. A delivery stick may be used
6. Teams will draw for hammer (LSD) in pre-game practice. Team listed first are throwing dark (red) stones will practice first and deliver the clockwise rotation (see Guide for details)
7. Semi-final games will not be tied together. If one gender has tie breakers and the other does not, the semi-final for the gender not requiring tie breakers will occur Saturday evening
8. Playoffs – after round robin, the first (1st) place team will advance to the finals. The second (2nd) and third (3rd) place teams play in a semi-final with the winner advancing to the finals (see Guide for details)
9. Meeting – the 3 teams involved in the playoffs will meet with the Chief Umpire immediately following the final round robin game. Stone handle colour will be determined at this time.
