

APPENDIX: WHEELCHAIR PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

See below for competition specific details. All other rules and details contained in the main body of the Competitor's Guide apply to this competition.

1. All games are 8 ends and are timed.
2. Thinking time is 36 minutes, extra ends are 6 minutes.
3. The fourth (4th) end break is seven (7) minutes.
4. A minimum of 4 ends must be played in round robin games and 6 ends in playoffs.
5. Teams will draw for hammer (LSD) in pre-game practice.
6. Playoffs – after round robin, the first (1st) place team will advance to the finals. The second (2nd) and third (3rd) place teams play in a semi-final with the winner advancing to the finals. (see Playoffs in Main Guide for complete details)
7. Stones are delivered from a stationary wheelchair positioned with 18 inches of the centre line.
8. The feet of the player cannot touch the ice during delivery.
9. The stone is delivered using a conventional arm/hand delivery OR an approved delivery stick.
10. Sweeping is not permitted.
11. All teams must be comprised of both genders.
12. Motorized wheel chairs are not permitted.
