

Head Coach, Curling

- Develop and maintain positive relationships with student athletes, peers, media and the curling community will be essential.

Qualifications:

- Post-secondary coaching and/or playing experience will be considered, an asset.
- Completion of the NCCP coaching certification level I (or equivalent) as a minimum would be considered an asset
- The preferred candidate will have elite level coaching experience.
- Effective interpersonal communication skills with the ability to work collaboratively in a diverse team-based environment and the ability to exercise good judgement.
- The ability to work flexible hours and travel, is required.
- Valid class 5 Drivers' License with the ability to provide a clear current driver's abstract.
- Must be able to pass a security clearance.
