Knights of Columbus Twin Arenas / Argyll Arena Rules and Regulations

- 1. Abuse of staff will not be tolerated. Ice requests and flood schedules are set up by the users, not by the staff. Any complaints in this regard should be directed to the management staff of the team.
- 2. Abuse of the facility will not be tolerated. A bill covering the cost of repairs caused by any member of the lessee's team will be sent to the lessee. Payment of such bill will be done 48 hours prior to the usage of the next normally scheduled ice time. If payment is not received as specified, the lessee's remaining ice times will be cancelled without further notice.
- 3. Parents are responsible for their children whether they are using the facility or spectating. If children, regardless of their age(s), are abusing the building or running throughout the facility, they will be asked to leave the building.
- 4. Any person who deliberately causes damage to the building in any way such as writing on or marking up the walls will automatically be expelled from the building and have to pay for damages.
- 5. The last user group of each day is allowed 30 minutes to vacate the premises. If this rule is not followed, the arena staff will not argue with the user. They will inform the group that their time is up and any extra time will be billed to the user group as ice time at the rate of \$125.00 per hour or part thereof. This charge will continue until the user group leaves the building. Failure to pay the additional charges will result in cancellation of the group's remaining ice schedule without further notice.
- 6. Garbage cans are supplied. Please use them.
- 7. Excessive beer/pop cans dumped in the parking lot will constitute loss of privileges.
- 8. No one is allowed on the ice until the zamboni leaves and the gate is closed. The zamboni will not be allowed on the ice before everyone leaves. When the whistle blows ending a game or period prior to a flood, leave the ice immediately. No sitting on the boards, hanging on the glass or smoking allowed.

Dressing Room Facilities

- 1. The dressing rooms are in a clean state at the beginning of each day. Each user group must leave the room in the same clean state. If not, you will be billed for the additional cleaning. If you receive the dressing room in dirty state, report it to the arena staff immediately. If you do not, you could be charged for the additional cleaning.
- 2. The management staff of each user group must be the last to leave and must ensure that the dressing room is left in its original clean state.
- 3. If paper supplies need to be refilled, please notify the arena staff. Supply of paper towels is for the convenience and comfort of the users.
- 4. The removal of broken hockey sticks, tape and other equipment and foreign objects from the dressing room is the responsibility of the user.

Ice Rules

- 1. All players on the ice shall wear CSA approved hockey helmets.
- 2. The conduct of the player is the responsibility of the player, coaches and leagues.
- 3. The Knights of Columbus Hockey Association and Argyll Arena are not responsible for any on or off ice conduct (behaviour) or injury to players, coaches or timekeepers.
- 4. The Manager, Coach or Team Captain shall be responsible for the conduct of their players at all times and will endeavour to prevent disorderly conduct before, during and after the game, on or off the ice, in the building or surrounding grounds. Notes of any occurrences should be made by the arena operator to Rink Manager.
