4.0 Business Arising from the Minutes

- 4.1. <u>College Hockey ACHC</u> (Brad and Jeff)
 - Review of 2016 ACHC budget
 - The tournament is an ADMHA fundraising event and needs support and commitment from the executive and the membership
 - ACHC would like to transition new people onto the planning committee every year to encourage fresh ideas, ADMHA members are encouraged to volunteer
 - 2017 event overview:
 - Tournament will be held over one weekend instead of two (2016), this will be easier on the volunteers; September 8th-10th
 - An Education Fair will be held on the Friday; high school children will be bussed in from around the district on that day. The female hockey teams will play at 1:00pm for the students followed by an autograph session.
 - \circ $\;$ Women teams will play in the afternoon, men will play in the evening.
 - \circ $\,$ Community dinner and "hot stove" event will take place on Saturday $\,$
 - The tournament will wrap-up on Sunday with the men's teams playing
 - \circ $\,$ Women's teams will both billet with local families this year $\,$
 - ADMHA rally squads will be able to practice with the teams, ATB will donate jerseys for minor hockey players again this year

4.2. <u>Music</u> (Sandra)

- 2016/2017 season there were complaints from the multiplex about inappropriate music (obscene language) being played during minor hockey events

7.0 League Representative - Kevin Danyluk

- In 2018/2019, *Alberta One League* will divide the province into four rural leagues, (Edmonton and Calgary will have leagues of their own)
 - Provincial play-offs will be for tiers 1 and 2, Peewee divisions and up.
 - o Teams will go to Provincials if they win their league
- NAI, Northern Alberta Interlock/ Interleague will continue for the 2017/2018 hockey season; 260 teams/31 associations will participate; North East League will not participate
 - Interlock, Tier 1 Peewee, Bantam, Midget divisions (will travel everywhere) with no travel caps
 - Interleague- tier 3 and tier 5
- Interlock evaluation game dates:
 - Tiers 1, 2, 3 September 29-October 06
 - Tiers 4 + 5 October 6-13

- Dates are flexible and organizations can ask for a black-out weekend and schedule tiering games at later dates
- October 31st is the deadline for teams to be moved to different tiers
- League starts October 6th
 - October 6th- January 15th majority of games will be scheduled
 - February will be reserved for play-offs, provincials and black out games
 - All teams will participate in play-offs, best of two games instead of best of three
 - Forfeits, will result in fines, teams must complete their games
 - Maximum of 2 tournaments per team, regularly scheduled games take priority
 - If you cancel games, you need to play between Christmas and New Year's
