You can choose to buy out your shifts up until Jan.1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 but there will be NO REFUNDS once shifts have been bought out.

Registration for the BAHA 2018-19 season will not be considered complete until:


- 1) Registration is paid in full (including outstanding fees from previous year)
