

## Notice regarding the cancellation of IP4.

**CANCELLATION OF THE IP4 PROGRAM The Initiation Program for 4 years olds will not be available in the 2018/2019 season. Alternate development options available in and around our community include:**

Due to ice constraints, we have cancelled the IP4 program for the 2018/2019 season. We will still have IP5 and IP6. This brings a lot of questions and concerns. If you wish to play for an alternate association that offers IP4, you may do so but you must complete your Respect in Sport parent course under your Beaumont address and under the Beaumont Amateur Hockey Association. You will also need a release form completed and signed by the BAHA president. This will make it easier for you when you try to register for IP5 the following season and allows everyone to follow protocol. At the end of the season, your file will be “returned to home” from the association you were playing in, in time for registration to open up here and you will be able to register your player as normal with BAHA for the 2019/2020 season.
