Volunteer Deposit Cheques

BAHA requires all Members who do not choose the volunteer buyout option at the time of registration to submit a non-dated cheque in the amount of \$300.00 payable to BAHA for each registered player.

Registration for the BAHA 2017-2018 season will not be considered complete until:

- 1) Registration is paid in full (including outstanding fees from previous year)
- 2) Volunteer commitment is bought out <u>OR</u>
- 3) Volunteer deposit cheque is received at the player first evaluation session

Players will not be permitted to attend evaluations until registration is complete as per above.

BAHA OFFICIATING CLINIC



The clinic for both new and returning officials will take place on Saturday September 9 at the KNRRC.

If you are interested in becoming an official you must meet the following conditions:

- 1. Be at least 13 years of age before January 1, 2018
- 2. Complete Hockey University online training (required for all new officials)
- 3. Attend a one-day Officiating Clinic
- 4. Pass the Hockey Canada National Referee Exam
- 5. Register as an official with Hockey Alberta
