 - Include position held, name of organization or activity you volunteer for.
- Include a letter from yourself stating why you are a deserving recipient of this award and how attending the Baseball Alberta Winter Camp would benefit you.
- Note that scholastic achievement information and school transcripts are NOT required to be submitted for this award.

Application Information:

- Applications must be submitted prior to October 1st, 2017.
- Applicants must be Canadian citizens who have been registered members of Baseball Alberta associations/clubs for a minimum of one (1) year.
