Mosquito AA Tournament Rules

- 1 Home Team supplies scorekeeper and visiting team tracks pitch count for both teams.
Completed score sheets and Pitch Count sheets must be returned to the Clubhouse.
- 2 Everybody bats and every player must play at least 2 defensive innings in the first 4 innings of a game.
- 3 All pitchers start with zero pitch count and current Baseball Sask Pitch count rules apply (below).
Pitch Count violations will result in a forfeit.
- 4 Umpires and opposing coach MUST have been notified regarding possible pitch count violation prior to the end of the game.
- 5 6 Inning games - 6 runs/inning mercy rule - game over if 10 runs up after 4 innings. Every inning shall have a 6 run limit, with the exception of an over the fence home run. No extra innings in round robin.
- 6 Home Team will not take last at bat if already ahead
- 7 2 hour time limit on all games except the playoffs.
- 8 Be at games early, may start earlier when needed.
- 9 Ties after round robin broken by head to head play, or if necessary by Tie breaking ratio –
– Runs against divided by the innings each team played while they were in a defensive position.
(Team A example - 14 runs against divided by number of defensive innings played 27.33 (14 ÷ 27.33 = .51 Ratio)
- 10 Wild card team will be determined by Baseball Sask tie breaking rules.
The 2-1 team with the lowest runs allowed per defensive innings played will be wild card team.
- 11 NO ALCOHOL AT THE PARK

2018 Baseball Sask Pitch Count Rules

- (1) Any player on the team is eligible to pitch, and there are no restrictions to the number of pitchers a manager may use in a game.
- (2) Pitchers shall be permitted to have 2 appearances in the same calendar day. If a pitcher requires a rest following 1st appearance, they cannot return in the same calendar day.
- (3) Pitcher cannot pitch 3 consecutive days unless a pitcher's first 2 days combined does not exceed:
Mosquito: 25, Pee Wee: 30, Bantam: 35
If pitcher's day 1 + day 2 exceeds figure above for their division, they require at least 1 days rest.
Pitcher cannot pitch 4 consecutive days. One (1) days rest is needed.
- (4) Pitchers and managers shall follow the following guidelines:

Mosquito	Pee Wee	Bantam	Rest required
1 - 25	1 - 30	1 - 35	None
26 - 40	31 - 45	36 - 50	1 Day
41 - 55	46 - 60	51 - 65	2 Days
56 - 65	61 - 75	66 - 80	3 Days
66 - 75	76 - 85	81 - 95	4 Days
75	85	95	Maximum

- (5) The official scorekeeper will calculate the total pitches thrown for that calendar day and determine the required rest starting the next calendar day. Athletes must not exceed the maximum pitch count total for that day.
- (6) **Once a player assumes the position of pitcher, they cannot catch for the remainder of the day.**
- (7) Pitchers will be permitted to finish the batter if his or her maximum pitch limit has been reached for that calendar day.
- (8) Intentional Walks will be included in Pitch Count totals.
- (9) Required Rest shall be defined in "Days" starting at 12:01am and ending at 11:59 pm of the next calendar day.
- (10) A pitcher who is removed from the mound during a game shall not be permitted to return to pitch in the same game, even if the pitcher is retained in the game at another position.
