### **Team requirements on the day:**

- You will be required to sign your player in at the Encana arena main doors. Players will remain with the volunteers above until signed out by parent.
- Minimum of 2 volunteers (1 on ice and 1 off ice) for your teams sessions all day and need to be at the registration desk 45 minutes prior to first session. Managers will be required to get this information in to me as soon as possible.
- Every player on your roster is expected to attend
- Every coach (head, assistant, goalie, trainer, etc) on your roster is expected to attend
- One parent from each family should plan on attending. More are welcome.
- Players will not have time to run to the concession during the day so please make sure they have a water bottle with their name on it and a nut-free snack if you feel they will need one.
- Clean running shoes for the dryland sessions at the fieldhouse and something comfortable for them to wear.
- The Camrose Kodiaks have graciously offered free tickets to all players that want to attend the game that evening. You just need to be wearing your CMHA jersey to get in.
- There will be prize draws on the day for teams with the most in attendance
