ADMINISTRATOR REPORT– written report. Added: upcoming Community Sport Plan event; opening of Rutland Centennial field; trying to find more fields options in the Mission; ball sizes at U9, BCSA manual says 3 or 4. First team listed uses their game ball size. Squad size at 9/10: if we go 7v7 then may have 12 registered.

October 5, 2017 Motion #1001 t was moved and seconded that all U9 teams will play 7v7 effective 2018 abiding with the maximum registrants as in the BCSA Small Sided Development Manual. Carried unanimously.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Sponsorship - Received donation from Storage Bear on the Westside. Maybe focus on indoor. Any sponsorship benefits COYSA and Clubs.

Facilities – Geotech is completed. Expecting the design in the next day or so. 50x60 field which means two U9/10 games or one 11/12. KU has gone back and forth with City of Kelowna for some permits and they are now in the final stages. Jason and Randall met to discuss contractors. What's a design of field involve? Design of everything underneath. When we have the design then the contractors bid. Lights are still on the table and within budget. Jason has looked at different contractors and the possibility to work with KU. KU wants to stress, we will work together as we all want to keep costs down. Can be a significant savings. KU is making progress. Numerous things City wanted to have happen and KU has done an amazing job finalizing the papers and meeting the City's requests. Once permits are up, it's the green light. Just have to approve a contractor and build. KU's timeline is November 15 for completion and if we can get this started, pretty close if doing at the same time. COYSA has to put in a permit for their portion. The front work has been done by KU that should help us. KU has already taken all the abuse. Why wouldn't we vote on a contractor? They haven't given a bid yet as they can't bid without a design. What's the turnaround for a quote? 1.5 weeks to give an honest bid. Once awarded, they get permits and get everything going. Are you looking at next COYSA meeting? No, would want to do an email vote. Need to get going pretty quickly. Costs will be higher than budgeted if we wait over the winter. Q: Jason, what's the best way to go? A: Surinder's work with the City is making it easier for us. Want to get it rolling fast as we can piggyback off issues Surinder already has been through. Legwork has been done. Other thing is we are in a timeline with School District No. 23, they wanted to have something up by end of October and we would've been there if not so many issues with City permit. We have \$450K in budget. One of the reason we are trying to complete it is so then we can apply for grants. With the money sitting there we can't apply. Will be an email to vote for contractor.

<u>Indoor</u> – World Cup theme on jerseys. Goalkeeper gloves are in. Shirts should be here in the next couple of weeks. Changed to 16 weeks instead of 17 to accommodate tournament not being on Spring Break. Went to an online registration system. All coaches are in place. Al does indoor ref scheduling and has his courses soon. Trying to create balanced teams. It's a tedious and time consuming task but want an awesome experience. 900 participants.
