

ELITE STEAM HOCKEY (AA & AAA) PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES

AAA – Bantam & Midget – Fort Saskatchewan AA – Peewee, Bantam & Midget – Sturgeon

Procedure if your child wants to tryout of for Elite Stream Hockey:

- 1. EVERYONE must register with CNN and follow the payment schedule.
- a. AA Fill out AA Notification of Try Out Form (TOF), available on CNN website.
 b. AAA Fill out AAA Notification of Tryout (TOF), available on CNN website.
- 3. Scan the TOF and send it to <u>cnnernie@gmail.com</u>. If registered and payment obligations are met, I will sign the form and email it back to you. I will target a 1 day turnaround typically after registration has been opened.
- 4. It is your responsibility to register with the AA or AAA team and follow their rules of participation. See respective websites for more information.
- 5. If your child is cut you must inform CNN executive ASAP. Very important.
- 6. If your child makes Elite Stream Hockey, you will be reimbursed any registration fee you have given CNN.

Although CNN encourages players to play at the highest level possible there is some risk and thing to consider when trying out for Elite Steam Hockey:

- 1. If you are trying out for Elite Stream Hockey, it is still a requirement to attend 2 of 3 tryout sessions with CNN and place high enough in the rankings to be guaranteed a spot on the "A" team if cut from Elite Stream Hockey.
- 2. In the best interests of CNN, the CNN executive may declare the team full at any time. If your child is trying out for an Elite Steam team he/she is not considered part of an CNN team, and if the team is declared full your child would be released. All attempts will be made to find a team in other associations for the player.
- 3. The Sturgeon draw area includes CNN, CR, Athabasca, Barrhead and Morinville Associations.
- 4. CNN registrations have been higher than projected in recent years and it's a very real possibility that a team may be full or cuts may happen.
- 5. There will be a date set where CNN teams will be created from those that have committed to CNN. This date will be determined in the fall.
