

Jean Andre Tyke Tournament Rules

The Jean Andre Tournament adopts the current BCLA/CLA Tyke Rules “L” and Regulations to govern all Tournament play, except where mentioned below:

Game Time

- Period length of 15 minutes running time – due to tournament play we are unable to go beyond allotted game times.
- 2 minute break between periods
- Players change on the fly
- 3rd period will be shortened accordingly if games are running late to stay on schedule.

Playing Surface

- 3x3 regulated nets will be used

We will use a regular hard ball for all tournament games.

Rules of Play

Face-offs to begin each period only:

- Ref will award possession to the goaltender of opposing team, after any goal.

After possession by the goalkeeper:

- **The defensive team must clear the offensive zone once all players cross half court, they are allowed to re-enter.**
- If any interference on the play of the ball or the player, the ball will be returned to the offensive team.

Penalties will be served by the offending player at the discretion of the referees. Teams will play a man down.

- **3 Pass Rule applies always. No breakaway rule.**
- Min 1 pass in the defensive zone, goalie pass will count
- Min 2 passes in the offensive zone prior to being allowed to count a goal
- Should a goal be scored prior to the above then possession will be awarded to the non-offending team. The 3 pass rule is reset after a goal
- The reset of the pass rule will occur only once the other team has moved the ball down the floor and into the other team's offensive zone. If a player with the ball is legally checked prior to crossing into the offensive zone the 3 pass rule would not apply.

Score will be kept on the clock. No goal differential more than 5 will be displayed. The final score shall be registered on the score sheet and must be signed by all officials for insurance purposes.

Referee

- There will be 2 referees per game
