Motion to Review and Approve August 21, 2018 Minutes:

New Business:

- **1. Motion made to Approve** September 16, 2018 Special Meeting Minutes for DMHA Exec and Midget Parents by Jon Morton, Seconded by Steve Benson; All in favor; Motion Carried
- 2. Midget Parents Presentation:
 - Concerns expressed about the evaluation process
 - some concerns about top midget team, ie why is it based only by numbers for players, and not the goalies; is there a way to evaluate goaltenders differently in future years; how are goalies ranked?
 - issues with the goalies who are coming back to DMHA at the last minute when they have been trying out for AA/AAA teams; fair tryouts for the DMHA teams during the evaluation process; why do the goalies need to be locked down to a team now, before game play has even been initiated by the league?; why are the exec's not watching the evaluations? A request to have one more fair evaluation opportunity for the goaltenders with the evaluators and maybe during some real gameplay
 - Comments made to leave the GT positions open and not placed team specific UNTIL all GT's have returned from AA/AAA tryouts and evaluate all the Goalies once they are all together. Moving forward make sure that all goalies are at every practice for BOTH



teams to allow the Coaching staff and goalies to police themselves for the best fit for team makeup.

- Jon Morton spoke about the reason why executive members ARE NOT PRESENT at
 evaluations: last years model was not working, therefore as an executive it was decided
 at the 2017 AGM to leave the evaluations process up to the outside evaluators that
 DMHA has hired. From 2016/17 feedback, it was stated that for fair Evaluations, the
 Goaltenders would be ranked based on numbers only with no intervention from
 coaches or executive members
- Jon Morton made a suggestion that more parent involvement is necessary; ie to show up at the AGM for voting and volunteer time on evaluations committee for input
- Joanna Parnell made a statement that questions/concerns about the goaltender evaluation process should be made at an earlier date and not during the evaluations week. Changes to the evaluation process take place months ahead of time and cannot be adjusted during the evaluation period and the process is voted on at the AGM.

 - **Evaluations update:** teams are built up to the PeeWee level, evaluation numbers for Bantam need to be handed in for team make up
 - Midget has 47 registered players with 4 goalies, 1 player release has been signed and is still out. Team 1 has 17 players with one out with an injury, 3 GT's which needs to be brought down to 2
 - A letter was sent out to two DMHA families with regards to outstanding registration balances from last season, and that if past due accounts are not cleared before month end, children will not be allowed on ice to play

 - 20 kids still out on releases
- 4. Referee Assignor: Brandy Fisher
 - Midget 1 will have problems finding refs with this level. Only has a total of 5 refs, loosing 3 from past years; Some refs from Edmonton have been contacted and is still waiting for



confirmation if they will be available; need to train more refs and push for faster training, two man ref system for Midget 2 is not as much trouble

- Has sent off the licencing fee for the travel raffle voucher
- 2 outstanding registration balances from last season have been looked at and the parents have been contacted; one check has been received and waiting on one more
