TOURNAMENT RULES

1. The tournament will be run in accordance with the official Hockey Canada/ Hockey Alberta rules.
2. Any questions can be addressed to one of the Tournament Coordinators.
3. Please RESPECT our officials. All referee decisions are final.
4. Any player who receives a misconduct in the last ten (10) minutes of a game will be required to sit out the next game. In all other cases, Hockey Canada/Hockey Alberta rules apply.

GAMES

1. All teams will play 3 games in the round robin & one game in the finals.
2. Teams should be dressed and ready 15 minutes prior to game time.
3. All games will consist of: Two minute warm ups, two - 20 minute run time periods, one - 15 minute stop time period and flooding after every game.
4. Two points for a WIN, one point for a TIE, Zero points for a LOSS.
5. There will be a presentation of Heart & Hustle and MVP given to players from each team after each game. MVP & HH to be chosen by your own team's coaches during the third period.
6. After your final game, all players will receive a tournament award.
7. Time-outs limited to one - one minute per game, per team.
8. Tie breakers will be determined by: (A) The winner of the game played by the 2 teams in the round robin shall advance. (B) If the game was tied in round robin, or if more than 2 teams tie, it will go to the team who scored the most goals in the round robin. (C) If still tied, it will go to the team that allowed the fewest goals against in the round robin. (D) If still tied, it will go to the team with the fewest penalty minutes in the round robin. (E) Coin toss.
9. In event of a tie in the Finals, there will be an "NHL-style" shoot-out. Each team will select three (3) players to take shots on the opposing goalie. Players from each team will alternate. Each shot will begin with the puck at center ice and the player will start his shot at the sound of the referee's whistle. In the event that the game is still tied after the first initial three players from each team have taken their shots, teams will continue to alternate players to take a shot on a "sudden-death" basis until the tie has been broken. No player may be selected to be a shooter a second time until all players have had an opportunity to shoot once.

10. The tournament has the right to shorten warm ups, drop clock, etc. to keep the tournament running on schedule.

CONDUCT

1. There will be zero tolerance of abuse of officials, players, spectators and the facility.
2. All coaches and managers are responsible for the conduct of their team and supporters.
3. Please leave your dressing rooms clean, free of garbage on the floors.
4. Have FUN!!!!

There will be a raffle table and progressive 50/50 draw in the upper part of the stands. Draws will be made at 7:00 Saturday night and all prizes will can be picked up that night or Sunday morning.
