

## Information for Becoming a Referee with Edmonton Inline

Edmonton Inline welcomes you to the league as a referee. As an applicant you must be 15 years of age or older and be able to handle yourself on roller blades. Knowledge of the inline hockey game is appreciated but we find that any experience with hockey officiating enables an easy transition to inline.

You will need the following equipment:

- CSA approved helmet with ½ visor
- Referee inline pants (can be purchased for \$45.00)
- Roller blades
- Official whistle
- Referee jersey (can be purchased for \$60.00)
- Roller Hockey Canada patch (\$4.50)
- Rule book (\$5.00)

EI offers the training for each of the Levels in April before our season begins. In order to referee you must attend these sessions.

### Level 1

- Designed for a referee with 2 or less years of experience refereeing inline hockey
- Classroom sessions will be held April 3 and 12<sup>th</sup> (attendance at both is required).
- The on surface instruction will be held April 12 after the test has been taken.

### Level 2 and 3

- Level 2 is designed for a referee 16 years of age with 2 or more years of experience.
- The Level 2 classroom session will be held April 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> 2017. Attendance at one of these meetings is required. The referee test will be written at this time.
- Level 3 is national level and this is by invitation only

### Fees:

- Referee's Registration Fee is \$35 - \$50 (covers clinic materials, hot lunch, insurance and registration, Instructors)
- Officials who are also registered as players will have rebate of \$8.00 for insurance.
