### **Volunteer Participation Hours Info for Managers/Families**

One \$200 post-dated cheque per family, given to Fort Saskatchewan Ringette Association, is to ensure that all families do a minimum of 10 hours of approved work that will benefit the association as a whole.

**Managers please collect all cheques by Oct. 31, 2014.**

If this 10 hour minimum is not met, the cheque will be cashed. Team Managers and the fundraising director will track hours, but it is up to each parent to make sure the hours are worked.

Below is a list of approved activities that will count toward the 10 hours:

Executive Position: 10 hours

Coach: 10 hours

Assistant Coach: 10 hours

Trainer: 10 hours

Manager: 10 hours

Diamond Ring Tournament Organizing Committee: 10 hours

Banquet Chairperson: 10 hours

Diamond Ring Tournament Assistance: Actual hours worked

Casino: Actual hours worked plus travel

Hawks Games: 3 Hours

Provincials: Actual hours worked

Work that does *NOT* count:

- Any team work that benefits individual teams: Score/Timekeeping for own team games, team jobs such as equipment, social activities, team fundraising, etc.
- Diamond Ring game volunteers: Concession, draw table, time/scorekeepers, penalty Box, 50/50 sales, etc.

Keep in mind that some jobs need to be filled whether everyone has filled their hours on the team or not. This is especially important at Provincials if we host them. Every team is expected to fill slots to help out.
