Report Summary

This recommendation will allow all EFHL teams to play an equal number of games against all opponents in their category

Over the past several years the standard number of games has been 20 for all tiers. The schedule inequities that result from three rounds of play led to teams having to play a tournament in order to select a team to represent Hockey Edmonton in provincial competition.

Hockey Edmonton Board has approved season long schedules for all Provincial Categories with no movement of teams.

Organization Outcomes

Teams will play all other teams in their tier equally, this principal will hold as tiers grow beyond 20 teams. This is a fair and equitable process for declaring a Hockey Edmonton representative for provincial championships. The highest ranked Edmonton team at the end of the regular season would be designated the Hockey Edmonton Provincial Representative.

Peewee AA: Provincial representative will be the winner of the Championship Playoff Tournament as per Hockey Alberta AA Model Rules

Budget/Financial Implications

If additional games are required to facilitate the season schedule more than the 20 games that players paid for in their registration fees, we will reduce the number of practices to accommodate the 40 ice times guaranteed by Hockey Edmonton. This schedule will eliminate the need for Hockey Edmonton teams to

have a provincial tournament round to declare the provincial representative.

Non Standing Games

Ideally, non-standing games for will be the first scheduled games of the season and be considered pre-season games and not recorded in the season standings.

If scheduling does not permit during the first games of the regular season, EFHL determines the first meeting between the two teams will be the non-standing game to be completed during the first month of the season.
