2017-18 Plan Outline

1. **Regional Goalie Leads** – create a network of six leads, one in each of our six regional centre areas. These leads will act as a resource for HA programming and also to providing service to MHA's. This is a volunteer position that will be compensated by HA or MHA's covering expenses and honorariums for work completed. All work will be booked directly through HA.
2. **Instructional Stream Level 1 Goalie Clinics** – these are clinics to further educate coaches in AB on the position and how to more effectively incorporate goaltenders into their practices. Our plan is to offer at least 18 of these clinics next year and currently HA absorbs all the cost to run these.
3. **Goalie Development Camps** – we do run a North and South camp and each camp consists of 36 goalies totaling 72 goalies being trained over a weekend. We partner with World Pro and ATC to deliver these camps. New one for us this year is our Elite Goalie Camp which will consist of 36 male goalies and 18 female goalies. This is an application process to attend and our target age groups are goalies playing AAA born 2002-2003 on male side and 2000-2003 on the female side. We are recruiting high level instructors to deliver this camp.
4. **MHA Implementation**
 - a. Development Director Training on how to create and execute a MHA Goaltender Development Plan
 - b. Goalie Coach Training Seminar – MHA's can send a person to get trained to support their associations goaltender development
 - c. Team Coach Education
 - d. Parent Education
 - e. Goalie Communication of resources





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5. **Communication** – creation of goalie specific section on our website and relationship building with alumni to enhance activation
