

Elite Coach Education Policy

Statement:

In an era where coaching staffs are required to work collectively to ensure team success, coach education of the **entire staff** is crucial. Although participating in a coach clinic does not guarantee coaching success, it is the educational foundation for working with athletes in any Stream of Play.

- The Elite Coach Education Policy will support the Hockey Development Coach Mentorship Policy.
- For the 2018-19 season and onward, Hockey Edmonton will strengthen the current Hockey Canada/Alberta NCCP coach certification requirements within the Elite Stream of Play (Peewee AA, Bantam AA/AAA, Minor Midget AAA, Midget AA/AAA, Female Elite, Female AAA).
- In conjunction with the most current Hockey Canada/Alberta NCCP coach certification requirements for Head Coaches, all Hockey Edmonton Assistant Coaches will be required to be trained at the coach certification level no less than the division immediately below the level that they are coaching at by November 15. **It is however desired that all Assistant Coaches within the Elite Stream of Play (Peewee AA, Bantam AA/AAA, Minor Midget AAA, Midget AA/AAA, Female Elite, Female AAA) become Hockey Canada/Alberta NCCP Development 1 trained/certified AND Checking Skills trained.**
- Hockey Edmonton Head Coaches will still be required to meet the current mandated Hockey Canada/Alberta NCCP coach certification requirements by November 15.
- No coach shall be registered onto a team roster for the sole purpose of meeting Hockey Canada/Alberta NCCP coach certification requirements. All coaches on a team roster must be regular coaches with that team. Please view the Hockey Edmonton Elite Coach Education Minimum Requirements below:

Purpose:

Numerous motivations were accredited when developing the Elite Coach Education Policy:

- To provide all Hockey Edmonton Coaches with a strong coach education foundation;
- To improve the knowledge and coaching skills of all Hockey Edmonton Coaches;
- To promote cohesive coaching staffs throughout Hockey Edmonton;
- To ensure that Hockey Edmonton athletes are interacting with the most qualified coaches;
- To ensure Hockey Edmonton Coaches are providing appropriate development plans, seasonal plans, curriculums, interactions, and programming to Hockey Edmonton athletes;
- To ensure that Hockey Edmonton athletes are optimally acquiring the appropriate mental, physical, and sport specific skills;
- To assist with improving Hockey Edmonton club team results;
- To assist with improving Hockey Edmonton club team WHL draft results;
- To provide a more attractive coaching environment for Edmonton born athletes, as compared to outside club options (CSSHL, HSL, etc.);
- To ensure a consistent approach is utilized for developing coaches and players throughout Hockey Edmonton;
- To increase qualified Hockey Edmonton coaching candidates and assist with coach recruitment;
- To better align with other "Western City" coach education requirements;
- To become a leader in coach education across Alberta and Canada.

Scope:

Coaches within the Elite Stream of Play will be accountable to this policy. We anticipate similar policies being incorporated into Hockey Edmonton's Community, Developmental, and Provincial Streams of Play, at later dates.

Responsibilities:

- The Hockey Edmonton Board and Executive are responsible for the appointment and maintenance of this policy;
- The Hockey Edmonton Development Manager is responsible for the development of the procedures to enact this policy;
- Each club, district, and operating area (CDOA) are responsible for the implementation and monitoring of the procedures of this policy;
- Hockey Edmonton staff, along with assistance from Hockey Alberta staff, will ensure/organize appropriate/reflective amounts of clinics to enact this policy.
