
Arena Camping Information





Notes about Camping:

- All groups should be advised that the open green space to the north of Camping area 1 will be under construction during this spring/summer. With that in mind there is NO designated tenting area.
- We ask that the camping areas are filled up according to number from 1-4.
- In areas 1 & 4, campers are not permitted to park on the grass, but may back up to the grass.
- Wheels from vehicles and trailers must stay on the paved or gravel areas.
- There should be a <u>clear and unobstructed</u> fire laneway around the Arena/Curling Rink facilities access by emergency vehicles as required.

Other municipal and/or provincial regulations that your guests must adhere to include:

- Open fires anywhere on town property are not permitted. Fires in portable fire pits may be approved a fire permit is required (Bylaw No. 1400). Permits applications can be found online @ http://innisfail.ca/departments-council/fire-department/fire-permits. Permits must be approved by the Innisfail Fire Chief.
- Excessive noise/nuisance is regulated by Community Standards Bylaw (No. 1498) and Parks Bylaw (No. 1440)
- Consumption of alcohol in town owned parks, playgrounds, sportsfields and green spaces is strictly prohibited.

Note that this area is not a campground. It is a parking lot.

Both are situated within town limits, and comfortable, with great facilities and take reservations.

An RV dumping station is also available within town. It is located at 4804 52 Ave. Payment can be made by credit card or via token. Tokens can be purchased at the Town Office (4943 53rd St) or at the Anthony Henday Campground.
