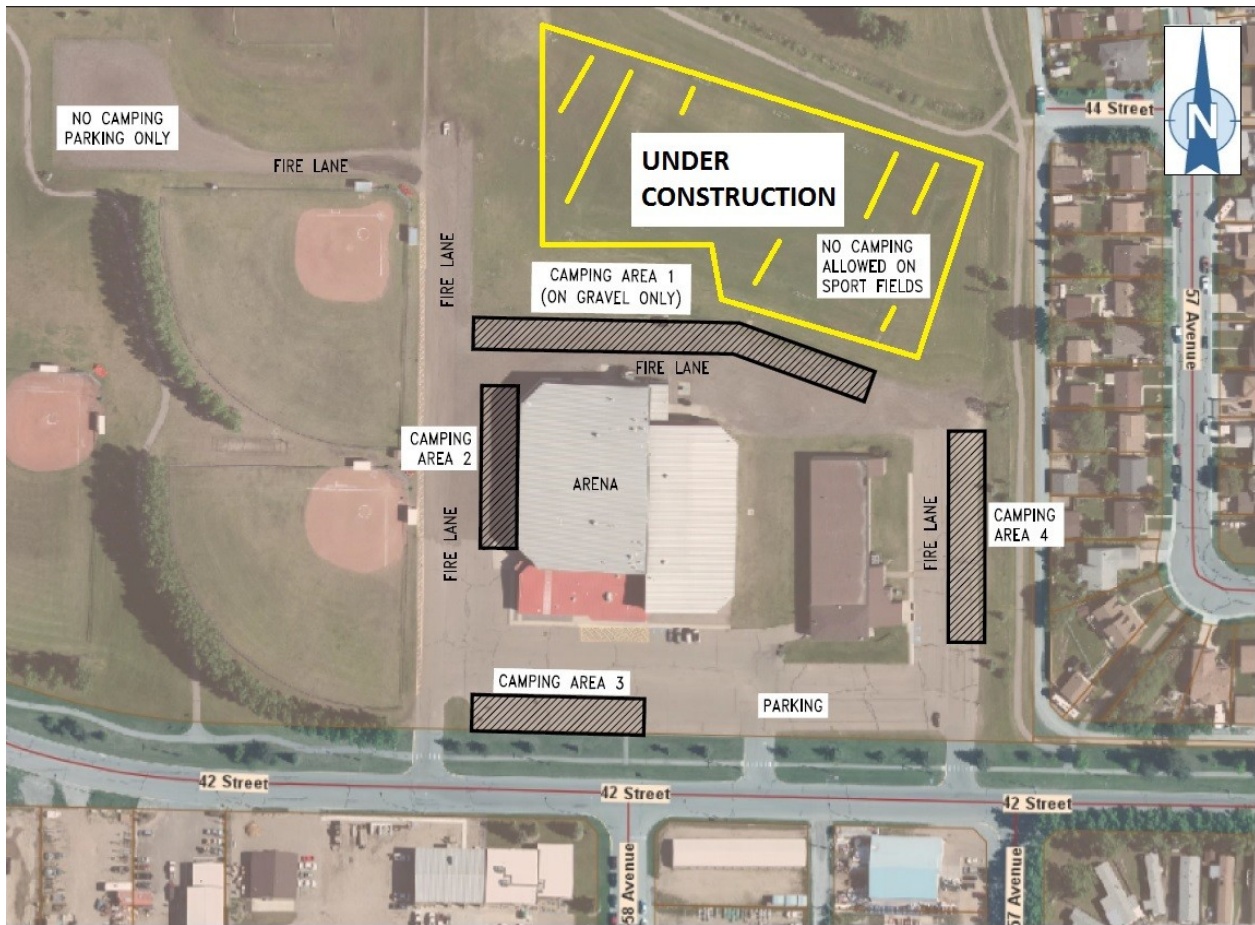


# Arena Camping Information



## Notes about Camping:

- All groups should be advised that the open green space to the north of Camping area 1 will be under construction during this spring/summer. With that in mind there is NO designated tenting area.
- We ask that the camping areas are filled up according to number from 1-4.
- In areas 1 & 4, campers are not permitted to park on the grass, but may back up to the grass.
- Wheels from vehicles and trailers must stay on the paved or gravel areas.
- There should be a clear and unobstructed fire laneway around the Arena/Curling Rink facilities access by emergency vehicles as required.

## Other municipal and/or provincial regulations that your guests must adhere to include:

- Open fires anywhere on town property are not permitted. Fires in portable fire pits may be approved – a fire permit is required (Bylaw No. 1400). Permits applications can be found online @ <http://innisfail.ca/departments-council/fire-department/fire-permits>. Permits must be approved by the Innisfail Fire Chief.
- Excessive noise/nuisance is regulated by Community Standards Bylaw (No. 1498) and Parks Bylaw (No. 1440)
- Consumption of alcohol in town owned parks, playgrounds, sportsfields and green spaces is strictly prohibited.

**Note that this area is not a campground. It is a parking lot.**
