RE: Updated Gaming Proceeds Policy, May 2016

Below are the current Association policies on fundraising activities that involve Gaming Revenue.

Victoria Grizzlies

Victoria Grizzlies have been supportive of our teams and have a program in place where our hockey teams can assist in the 50/50 draw on game nights and they will receive a portion of the 50/50 net proceeds. For these games, all proceeds from these games will be retained by the team running the 50/50.

Westshore Wolves

Westshore Wolves have also been supportive of our teams and allowed us to run a 50/50 draw at their games as with the Grizzly Games. For these games, all proceeds from these games will be retained by the team running the 50/50.

Victoria Royals

The Victoria Royals have a fundraising program in place where our teams can sell a block of tickets, provided their block is sold, they are eligible to run a Chuck a Puck fundraiser or a 50/50 Draw. For these events 70% of the proceeds transferred back to the team.

Tournaments

JDFMHA Tournaments hosted by teams. For tournaments, 70% of the proceeds are transferred back to the team.

Team Raffles

Please contact VP of Administration to present your raffle idea for consideration and approval. Note that raffles require a gaming licence. If approved, the team will have 70% of the proceeds transferred back.

For anything requiring a gaming licence, the Gaming Enforcement rules are that 100% of proceeds are retained by the association for use funding gaming approved expenses. The JDFMHA Executive voted and have agreed that we will match those proceeds and pay 70% back to the team by way of a direct transfer into the team account, the other 30% matched will be transferred to our Bursary and Scholarship fund. This fund is used to help families and more

specifically kids in our local hockey community as well as to recognize exceptional kids graduating that have been part of our organization. For all licenced gaming events and tournaments, your budget and all proceeds should be balanced and submitted to the office for deposit. Once it has been reviewed, and the licence requirements have been met, the team matched proceeds will be deposited to the team account.
