Hi Sheryl & Harold,

I am unable to attend tonight's meeting so am sending along a quick rundown of ice :)

- finally received the remainder of the SI league schedule from VIAHA so those games have been input (yay)
- rep playoff round robin ice has been sent to VIAHA
- scheduling will start to slow down a bit now as it becomes more "week to week" based on playoff results
- most teams have had 2-3 exhibitions with a few exceptions I hope to finish that allocation soon
- goalie sessions were all allocated and completed before the Christmas break
- power skating session have been a struggle this year as the instructors have very limited availability. I never heard back from Blaine for scheduling anything with him, and Mena can only work later evenings out of JDF which has not suited our ice schedules. Dennise had been working with teams up until the Christmas break but again - her availability is limited. It has been difficult to schedule the younger age groups as she prefers to work with teams between 6-9pm out of Westhills only and cannot accommodate anything between 4 and 5 when we generally schedule Atom and Peewee. It might be a good idea to review this program for next year.
