Scheduling has been a bit of a challenge with Jr A and B play off, ice being pulled back, but everything is rescheduled now good to go. Family Day Atom A event was successful and they made approximately \$6k, which is great for a 6 team tournament. Regarding the Ice allocating software, Wayne Richard signed the NDA and the new developer has been provided the source code and application for review. I am waiting on a firm quote before proceeding with update. UPDATE: Ice software was \$4k
