

ONLINE REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS:

A parent or guardian of a player follows the link to the online registration system managed by [Hockey Canada](#). If you did not register your child online last season, you will be required to create an account with a username and password. **Your username is your email address so if you have changed your email address since last season, you will need to use your old email address as your username or create a new account with your new email address.**

You do not need your child's Hockey ID number to register them, but it will appear beside your child's name once you add them to your account. It is a good idea to know this number, so please make a note of it. If you do not see your child's name, make sure the spelling is correct as some players have been registered as short form or nickname - i.e. Robert, Robbie, Rob. **Unless you would like all correspondence (receipts, ice times, etc.) to go to your child, please do not include their email address in the online registration information.**

The Hockey Canada online registration program is not set up to accept payment at the time of registration. Fee payments are to be made directly to Kamloops Minor Hockey. Once your child is registered you can start making payments towards their registration fees. Please see the FEES & PAYMENT OPTIONS document for more information on fees.

If you have 3 or more players to register with our association, you can include the Family of 3 discount. If you are not sure if there will be 3 registering, we can adjust the fees manually at the KMHA office.

Zone/MML/Junior Team tryouts (applies to Bantam and Midget aged rep players) – please indicate on the online registration of the players intention to tryout for other teams. Fees are not due for players trying out for other teams until it is determined that the player will be participating in our association. Fees MUST be paid in full prior to any participation on the ice.

Please make sure that you have checked-out at the end of the registration process, otherwise the registration will not be complete and your child will not be registered. To confirm that your child's registration was successful, make sure that you can print an Invoice for the 2018-19 season. **If you cannot print an invoice, then the registration did not go through.** You can also contact the KMHA office to confirm that the registration was successful.

Female-only teams – the number of females registering for female-only teams (both rep and recreational) will determine the number of female-only teams that we have.

Carpooling/Team Placement requests – due to the large number of players in our association and the need to try and balance teams, requests to be on a specific team with another player/coach will not be accepted.
