## SOCIETY ACT

## CONSTITUTION

1. The name of the society is **KOOTENAY EAST YOUTH SOCCER ASSOCIATION.**
2. The purposes of the Society are:
  - a. To foster, develop and promote the game of soccer amongst all youth in the district of Kootenay East;
  - b. To govern the rules of play of the game of soccer amongst all youth in the district of Kootenay East;
  - c. To strive for the highest standards in skill, fair play and sportsmanship;
  - d. To develop and train referees and coaches to assist in the delivery of a quality soccer program;
  - e. To generally provide whatsoever other assistance is available from the Society to support and encourage participation in the game of soccer amongst all youth in the district of Kootenay East.
3. In the event of dissolution or winding up of the Society, all of its remaining assets, after payment of liabilities, shall be distributed to one or more charitable organizations recognized by Revenue Canada as being qualified as such under the provisions of the *Income Tax Act* of Canada from time to time in force.
4. The Society shall be carried on without purpose of gain for its members and any profits or other accretions to the Society shall be used in promoting its purposes.
5. The directors and officers of the Society shall serve without remuneration and neither the directors nor the officers shall receive directly or indirectly any profit from their position in the performance of their duties.
6. The Society may invest funds in any or all of the following:
  - a. Investments authorized by the Laws of Canada for the investment of funds of Life Insurance Companies.
  - b. Any investments authorized by Section 15 of the *Trustee Act* of the Province of British Columbia for the investment of trust funds.
7. The operations of the Society are to be chiefly carried on in Kimberley and Cranbrook and surrounding areas, in the Province of British Columbia. *THIS PARAGRAPH IS ALTERABLE.*
8. The Kootenay East Youth Soccer Association is affiliated with the British Columbia Soccer Association (BCSA) and is subject to the rules and regulations of that body and with the British Columbia Soccer Association and the Canadian Soccer Association. *THIS PARAGRAPH IS ALTERABLE.*
9. In accordance with the *Society Act* it is hereby stated that paragraphs 3, 4, 5, 6 and 9 of this Constitution are unalterable.
