Please note:

1. Board member positions of Leduc Ringette count as all three (3) Fundraising/ Volunteer commitments. You must first select your three (3) options to process your players registration. Once received, Leduc Ringette will confirm the board position and remove your three (3) Fundraising/Volunteer commitments previously selected.

2. Head coaches count as all three (3) Fundraising/Volunteer commitments. You must first select your three (3) Fundraising/Volunteer commiments and submit a coaching application. If you are selected to Head Coach by the Coach selection committee, Leduc Ringette wil remove your three (3) Fundraising/Volunteer commitments previously selected.

3. Assistant coaches count towards two (2) Fundraising/Volunteer commitments. You must first select your three (3) Fundraising/Volunteer commitments and submit a coaching application. If you are selected to Asst. Coach by the Coach selection committee, Leduc Ringette wil remove two (2) of your Fundraising/Volunteer commitments previously selected.

4. Team managers count as three (3) Fundraising/Volunteer Commitments. You must first select your three (3) Fundraising/Volunteer commitments and submit a manager application. If you are selected to manage a team, Leduc Ringette will remove your three (3) Fundraising/Volunteer commitments previously selected.

5. Junior coaches count towards two (2) Fundraising/Volunteer commitments. You must first select your three (3) Fundraising/Volunteer commitments and submit a coaching application. If you are selected to Junior Coach by the Coach selection committee, Leduc Ringette wil remove two (2) of your Fundraising/Volunteer commitments previously selected.

Consent for Release of Information

The Freedom of Information Policy (FOIP) requires that we have Parent/Guardian consent in order to post your child's name and/or photo on the Ringette Websites, newspapers and/or any public domain.

The following are examples of activities where information collected may be used:

1. The use of player's name and/or photo in local newspapers.

2. The use of player's name and/or photo and/or comments on the Leduc Ringette Website.

3. The taking of individual or team photo.

4. The use of player's name and/or photo on arena community board.

5. The use of player's name in tournament programs, etc.

6. The circulation of information on a "need-to-know" basis regarding players who have medical conditions.

NOTE: Only required information will be provided to RAB and/or BGL as required for players, team staff and referee registration.

We realize, however, that there may be occasions where you, as parents or guardians, have concerns relating to the safety of your child and any of these uses of information. If this is the case, please contact the Leduc Ringette Association President.

This is to cerfity that the contained information is correct and that:

1. I understand that should extenuating circumstances arise, or a full team cannot be filled, this registration does not guarantee the Player a team to play on.

2. I consent to the above named Player participating in Ringette and, in the event that the Player requires medical attention, a Team Official to obtain treatment.

3. I relieve the Leduc Ringette Association, Coaches, and Sponsors of any responsibilitiy for any accidents or injury, which may occur as a result of participation.

4. I understand that the registration fees ****DO NOT**** conver the entire costs of Ringette. Players and Parents will be expected to raise additional money through fundraising and other activities.

5. <u>I understand that I will be required to volunteer for the Team and the</u> Association, or forfeit my volunteer fees.

6. I have read and agree with the Consent for the Release of Information as outlined.

7. I agree to receive emails from the Association regarding ringette information, camps, equipment, etc. If I wish to no longer receive these emails, I will contact the Association Registrar.

Miscellaneous Information

1. Registration deadline is June 30th for Returning Players; registrations after this date will have a \$200 late fee. <u>NEW PLAYERS or ACTIVE START players are</u> not charged this late fee.

2. Fees are due in full by Setember 1, 2017.

3. Fees paid by cheque may ONLY be post dated for the 15th and 30th of the month.

4. There will be a \$25 charge on all NSF cheques.

5. Fundraising fees are NOT included with the registration fee. Any monies received from raffle tickets sold as part of your Fundraising/Volunteer commitment must be turned into the Leduc Ringette Treasurer.

6. Players must apply in the appropriate age division. If they wish to play 'up' or 'down' a division they must submit a 'player movement request form'.

7. All new players must provide government issued proof of Date of Birth.
