

Name of Scholarship:	Sean Gurney/Lethbridge Lacrosse Association Scholarship
Objective:	To recognize a Lethbridge Lacrosse Association (LLA) player who has completed high school and contributed to Lethbridge Lacrosse Association and his/her community through volunteerism; assisting the individual in the pursuit of post-secondary studies.
Value:	\$1,000.00
Number of Awards Issued Annually:	1 or 2 (please see Other Considerations)
Number of Years the Scholarship will be Awarded:	Potentially 10 years, depending on the number of scholarships awarded annually
Where Tenable:	At any recognized post-secondary institution
Eligibility Criteria:	The applicant must be a current player and/or volunteer with the LLA. The applicant must have proof of community volunteerism in the last 2 years. Preference will be given to volunteers of the LLA.
Application Deadline:	August 10 of each year
Application Procedure:	Applicants must submit a letter to the LLA board of directors requesting the scholarship and explaining the role Lacrosse has had in their life. The letter must also describe the applicants personal characteristics, attitudes and values. Applicants must complete the application form provided. Two reference letters must be provided in support of your application. Applications must be received by August 10, 2015. The scholarship will be awarded and announced by September 1 of each year.
Selection Process:	<p>The recipient will be selected based on the following scoring procedure:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 2 points for every hour of volunteer work with Lethbridge Lacrosse Association in the past 2 years, to a maximum of 60 points ➤ 1 point for every hour of other volunteerism in the community in the last 2 years, to a maximum of 20 points ➤ 1 point for every year playing with the Lethbridge Lacrosse Association to a maximum of 10 points ➤ Up to 10 bonus points for reference letters that describe the applicant as having some of the characteristics that Sean exemplified; including leadership, integrity, determination and enthusiasm <p>A committee comprised of 2 LLA board members and Gina Gurney will review all applications and determine which student has the highest number of points.</p>
Presentation of Award	The recipient will be notified by letter, and have their name posted on the LLA website. The award will be paid directly to the recipient.

Disbursement of First Award:	The first award under this scholarship program was issued in September 2013.
Donation	The initial donation is approximately \$10,000
Is Tax Receipt Required?	No tax receipts will be issued
Investment and Earnings	Planned lifespan of scholarship is approximately 10 years. If

	<p>further donations are received, the scholarship will continue until there is less than the \$1000.00 needed to award the scholarship in any given year. Any moneys remaining in the scholarship account will be donated to the general operating account of the LLA.</p>
<p>Other Considerations:</p>	<p>Applicants may apply for the scholarship as many times as they like but the scholarship will only be awarded to a person once. In the event of a tie the committee will make the final decision (based on the bonus point scoring process) as to who will be awarded the scholarship or if both applicants will be awarded a \$1000 scholarship. No more than two scholarships will be awarded each year.</p> <p>A report indicating the recipient(s) each year, the value of the scholarship, and the Post Secondary Institution to which it was paid will be presented to Board of Directors of the LLA by the October Board Meeting each year.</p>
<p>Fees</p>	<p>Fees incurred to manage the scholarship fund will be applied to the scholarship.</p>
