

## **MACKLIN MINOR HOCKEY ASSOCIATION BINGO POLICY**

**Associate Members are required to work the Macklin Community Bingo as part of their yearly fees to the Association. The number of Bingo events will be determined by the number of Active Members in the Association in that calendar year. Associate Members will be required to follow the Macklin Community Bingo Worker Guidelines.**

### **Bingo Worker Guidelines:**

- ▲ Bingo workers are to arrive at the Macklin Communiplex at 6:00PM and are required to remain there until Bingo ends and then assist with the clean up before leaving.
- ▲ Your name will be checked off at the Bingo when you show up for work. If you have traded and are working for someone, please make sure this is noted and marked on the worksheet at the bingo.
- ▲ Failure to show up for your shift will result in a fine as set by MMHA as the beginning of each season.
- ▲ If you are unable to work your shift you may hire an alternate worker or find your own replacement. There is a list of people to hire on the website. The rate of pay is between you and the person you hire.
- ▲ You will be assigned a position when you arrive to work.
- ▲ Workers are not allowed to play Bingo on their scheduled night to work.
- ▲ Six people minimum are required to work each Bingo. Please DO NOT assume you will not be needed
- ▲ Jobs include selling Bingo Cards, Bonanza, Wildcards and Nevada's. Also 2 people will be asked to walk the floor also selling and confirming winners.

If you have not received notification when you work it is your responsibility to find out when you do. Usually you will work every 3-4 months or so.**
