Code of Conduct Agreement ... for Players

- 1. I will play hockey because I want to, not just because my parents or others want me to.
- 2. I will play by the rules of hockey, and in the spirit of the game.
- 3. I will control my temper. I realize that fighting and 'mouthing off' spoil the activity for everyone involved.
- 4. I will respect my opponents.
- 5. I will do my best to become a true team player.
- 6. I will remember that winning isn't "everything". It is also important to have fun, improve my skills, make friends and try to do my best.
- 7. I will acknowledge all good plays and performances, including those of my teammates and of my opponents.
- 8. I will remember that coaches and officials are there to help me. I will accept their decisions and show them respect.

Code of Conduct Agreement ... for Parents

- 1. I will not force my child to participate in hockey. I will realize it is something he or she *wants* to do.
- 2. I will remember that my child plays hockey for his/her enjoyment not for mine.
- 3. I will encourage my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to temper tantrums, hostility or violence.
- 4. I will teach my child that doing one's best, having fun, making friends and improving his or her skills is as important as winning. By doing so, my child will not feel defeated by the outcome of a game.
- 5. I will make my child feel like a winner by offering praise for competing fairly and trying his or her hardest.
- 6. I will never ridicule or yell at my child for making a mistake or for losing a game.
- 7. I will remember that children learn best by example. I will applaud good plays and performances by my child, by his or her teammates and by his or her opponents.
