Casino Volunteer Descriptions:

CHC Only denotes that these positions must be head by members of the CHC Association. CHC Association members consist of families that live in the following neighbourhoods: Cambrian Heights, Crescent Heights, Highland Park, Highwood, Mount Pleasant, North Haven, Rosedale, Rosemont and Tuxedo

General Manager (CHC Only):

The General Manager is responsible for the overall continuity of the casino. Makes sure all volunteer staff arrives and if not, has access to reliable "back-up" volunteer phone numbers. Some data entry involved. Can fill in for any volunteer position for a short period (not a complete shift) of time if needed.

Banker (CHC only):

The banker is the supervisor of the Cashier's Cage. The Banker will document all transactions to ensure the security of the chips and will supply chips to the gaming floor as required.

Cashier:

The cashier redeems players' chips for cash but does not sell chips.

Chip Runner:

The Chip Runner participates in the opening and closing of games with the floor staff. Transfers fill/credit request from floor staff to Banker and then transfers chips from Banker back to the game.

Count Room Supervisor (CNC only):

The Count room Supervisor witnesses and verifies every aspect of the count from table money boxes, supplies cash to the Banker as required, and assists in preparation of bank deposits and reports.

Count Room Staff:

The count room staff counts the funds of the casino. There are 4 count room positions:

- 1. Sorter: Sorts all cash or chips by denomination
- 2. Counter: Counts the sorted cash or chips, by denomination
- 3. Recorder: Records the number of bills, coins, and chips counted
- 4. Amalgamator: Verifies the cash or chips counted and groups them into bundles and summarizes the cash and chips with the count room supervisor
