*NCCP certification maintenance is now required for Development 1 and High Performance 1. As of January 1, 2014 coaches have five (5) years to amass maintenance points (Professional Development Points) to keep certified. Points are accumulated by attending NCCP program updates, attending accredited seminars / presentations, actively coaching and retaking certification courses. This will only apply to Development 1 and High Performance 1. This is subject to change. It is expected that additional maintenance events will be added. Coaches will be required to monitor their HCR record and be aware of the maintenance points required.
