4. Information

- d. Teams may play different numbers of games with some opponents
- e. Two games in a single day cuts down on travel with short game lengths
- f. Teams that are registering in the NAI will need to create a Novice major team in the Hockey Canada Registry so a HCR roster can be provided to the league

6. Discipline
