Concussion Protocol

Hockey Canada has developed a new policy that is designed to act as a framework to concussion prevention in the game and sets expectations around education, awareness, and responsible play at all levels. All members of Hockey Canada and Hockey Alberta are to adhere to this policy.

Concussion recognition tools, checklists, posters, and videos are available on the Hockey Alberta website.

Coaches, managers and parents are encouraged to review the information provided by Hockey Alberta.

Coaching Clinic

A coaching clinic is being offered at the New Sarepta Agriplex on January 22 at 6pm. This course is offered free of charge and is open to all coaches, managers and parents.

The Instructional Stream - Skating clinic is a 3-hour course that includes both in-class and on-ice components. You will need skates, a stick, a CSA approved helmet, gloves and a pen and paper.
