Questions or Comments:

Kim Saunders: Shortage of female goalies, are we looking at initiatives to encourage players to become goalies?

- We are looking at now having 4 goalies on the ice with the new novice rules, which will put more players into goalie positions
- Calgary is even shorter, Jamie can look at adding in some extra Sunday night goalie
- We are open to conversation with a group of goalie parents to work on ideas

Mike Aasen: Regarding tiering female, something to look at is affiliation for players, would like to see coaches mandated to allow players to play up if requested by a higher coach

- Agreed that kids need the opportunity to allow it for development, but it is a conversation for coach to coach, then to parents and players. If needed, you can escalate it to include the Director, etc.
- Parent question: female affiliation, previously it looked like some teams were pulling from higher up
 - With the females now being tiered, this process will look similar to the coed league and we will update the
 affiliation policy to reflect that

Matt Crawford: How will novice play out this year?

- Jamie has attended lots of meetings on this in the past month, will be looking at hosting a Novice only meeting next month to explain more
- It's mandated in 2019 but OMHA is doing it this year to work out the kinks beforehand
- OMHA across all novice teams will be ½ ice; lots of other associations doing the same; small towns not really wanting it; some associations are doing 2nd years have full ice, 1st years have ½ ice
- Looking at one large ice card for novice like they do in initiation to allow for easier affiliation must be like for like, house can't pull from travel
- ½ ice will allow for new practice plans that include more stations
