Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission

The Alberta Gaming & Liguor Commission has scheduled a Gaming Information for Charitable Groups (GAIN) combined session near you! The session is **Tuesday February 6th, 2018**, at the Best Western Plus Okotoks Inn & Suites, 100 Southbank Road, Okotoks at 9am-1pm.

This session is for all charitable groups who have a gaming licence or who would like to learn how to get a gaming licence and who would like more information on how gaming funds may be used. Examples of groups would be:

- Museum Society
- Sports groups curling, soccer, hockey, skating, golf
- School Education Associations
- Historical Society
- Senior Clubs
- **Church Organizations**

The Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission facilitator will cover the following topics:

- Eligibility for gaming Licenses and the Licensing application process.
- Requirements for conducting a, Casino, raffle, bingo or pull -ticket events.
- Policies around the use of gaming proceeds and how to get approvals (examples of forms). New Forms & policies for Donations
- Financial reporting requirements.
- Able to ask guestions
- GAIN manual provided (Eleventh Edition-July 2017)!!

This session will provide valuable information to charitable groups by helping them gain a better understanding of the responsibilities and requirements of their gaming licence.

Okotoks Oilers Pee Wee AA Black Team announced as a semi-finalist in the Chevrolet Good Deeds Cup!

As part of player development, the team wanted to give back to the community in the form of volunteerism. In December, the team held a bottle drive in the Okotoks community to raise funds necessary to make 300 lunches and donate these to the Calgary Mustard Seed (the number of lunches served daily). Okotoks Sobeys generously provided a discount on the necessary food and supplies. The boys made sandwiches and assembled the lunches (with guidance from team parents) and delivered them to the Mustard Seed along with an additional cheque for \$800, the remaining funds earned during the bottle drive.

Along with the community volunteerism, the team entered the Chevrolet Good Deeds Cup competition. This initiative encourages Pee Wee level teams across Canada to 'win off the ice' by helping make their community a better place. The Okotoks Oilers Pee Wee AA Black was selected as one of ten semi-finalists from across Canada, and is the only team from Alberta to reach the semi-finals. As a semi-finalist, the team receives a \$2000 donation to a charity of their choice (The Mustard Seed) and each team member receives a gift package of Hockey Canada and Chevrolet branded items.

The team is asking for your support to help them become a top three finalist. If successful, the prize package increases to receiving up to \$15,000 for their charity. Voting occurs from 12:00:01 AM on Monday, January 15th to 11:59:59 PM on Sunday, January 28th. Votes are counted by number of views on the Chevrolet Canada's YouTube Channel.
