GOALIE DEVELOPMENT

Okotoks Minor Hockey Association is hosting a goalie mentoring program for coaches/goalie coaches within OMHA. The instructors, Hi-Tek Sports Group, will cover both on and off ice topics. On ice material will include movements, age specific drills, warm-ups and stretches. The off ice material will include drill design, safety and preparation, equipment fit and will review the on-ice material. - * This clinic is for registered OMHA coaches only. 45 mins of classroom, 60 mins of on ice followed by approx. 20 minutes of off ice debrief.
- * Novice/Atom coaches please register for the Oct 24th session as this material will be more specific to that age.
- * Peewee/Bantam/Midget coaches please register for the Oct 25th session as this material will be more specific to that age.
- * Please bring helmet, skates, gloves and stick for the on ice component.
- * This clinic is designed for the one coach per team that will be tasked with working with the goaltenders and will be the part time goalie coach on their respective team. If space is available we will consider offering those seats to any other OMHA coach who may also be interested. Hockey Alberta mandates that one parent of every player take the Respect in Sport course. This course must be renewed every 4 years so if you completed the course the first year it was implemented, you will need to take this course again before your child hits the ice!
