TEAM ASSIGNMENT Guidelines

Established: March 17th 2008

Recreation (House) Team Assignment

- 1. Recreation (House) teams will be established by the Division Director with a goal of creating balanced and competitive teams.
- 2. Players will be evaluated by committee and ranked for purposes of a draft process.
- 3. A draft will be held by the designated Head Coaches with the guidance of the Division Director based on the evaluation and ranking. In the absence of a Head Coach, the Director will select players.
- 4. Head Coaches will be assigned to the teams at the conclusion of the draft. Allowances will be made by the Director for the Coach's own children as needed.
- 5. The Director's decision will be final at the time the teams are established.
- 6. Players will be assigned to a team within their respective age group Division.
- 7. Players may be reassigned to other teams/Divisions at the discretion of the Risk Committee at any time for reasons based on player development, safety or skill level, team balance/ competitiveness or any combination thereof.
- 8. Player movement will be done in consultation with the affected player, parents, coaches and Division Director(s).
- 9. Rep Tier 2 & Tier 3 Guideline #20 further details the movement of Rep players.
- 10. Players may only play for teams other than their assigned team pursuant to the Affiliated Player (A/P) rules and OMAHA Rules. Such movement must have the approval of the Division Director. Further, such opportunities to play for other teams must be shared equitably amongst available & willing players as determined by the Division Director.
- 11. No team to be assigned more than two goalies and if the situation arises, the last goalie registration received will be offered a skater position or placed on the wait list for an opening to occur.
