## ST. ALBERT RAIDERS HOCKEY CLUB POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

## 1. **CO-ED DRESSING ROOMS**

## 1.1 Policy Statement

Teams may be comprised of both male and female athletes. Teammates are expected to conduct themselves in an exemplary manner both on and off the ice. In addition to all existing Hockey Canada and Hockey Alberta rules, the following rules apply to all teams with both male and female athletes. Players may be suspended indefinitely for violation of these rules.

## 1.2 Rules and Guidelines

- 1.2.1 Male and female players may not change in the same room at the same time.
- 1.2.2 It is the responsibility of the Coach to ensure all players are included in both the pre-game and post- game hockey activities.
- 1.2.3 When separate facilities exist for both male and female participants, males and females shall make use of these separate facilities.
- 1.2.4 If the facility does not have separate change areas available, players shall address the issue by dressing, undressing, and showering in shifts. It is the responsibility of the team to provide a plan that will ensure the safety and privacy of individual players when they are dressing, undressing and showering.
