



### **"A" teams in Red Deer for the upcoming Box Lacrosse Season**

The league that Red Deer A teams participate in has revised their rules and the CDLA has removed the import rule for Red Deer teams. Therefore, any player within CALL that attends tryouts for the A team is eligible with out any restrictions to make the team.

In an effort to ensure that each year the players in the Peewee, Bantam, and Midget age groups have the opportunity to try out for a responsible "A" program, we have put in place a few guidelines to improve the experience and team from the start.

Here is how RDLA will determine if we will pursue "A" teams in **each division**.

1. Tryouts for all "A" teams will be in the month of February. There will be a deadline to register to tryout for all "A" teams set one week prior to the first try out date.
2. There must be **25** players registered prior to the deadline defined above in each division in order for RDLA to hold tryouts. If there is not 25 players registered in a division, there will be no "A" team for that division and refunds will be provided.
3. Try out fee for an "A" team will be \$50.
  - No refunds will be issued, this is a one time fee per season.
4. Red Deer resident players must register for the Box Season in their division as well as the "A" team tryout in order to participate in the evaluation.
5. Players from other associations (non Red Deer residents) must bring a signed CALL Player Tryout Form (available on the CALL web site at [www.centralalbertalacrosse.com](http://www.centralalbertalacrosse.com)) and register for the "A" tryout in their division. Players that do not have this form competed will not be able to participate.
6. No player will be permitted to tryout unless the \$50 fee is paid in full.
7. Each participant must attend at least 2 tryouts or they will not be considered for the team.
