

Introductory Ringette Director Description

For the 2016/2017 Season, RDR piloted an 8 Session Introductory Ringette program. The program was trialed as a way to provide a reasonable cost entry level way to learn ringette skills in a non-competitive environment. This will hopefully prepare the participants to take part in the following season thus encouraging higher registration for our regular program.

Due to the success of the program, RDR would like to extend it for next season. This position is still tentative as the Executive will have to approve continuation of the program next season.

As director, the primary role functions are:

Work with the Ice Allocator to arrange 8 sessions of ice for the program. The idea would be to start in January following the Friends on Ice Tournament.

Arrange coaches to lead the sessions. Sessions can be leveraged from what was learned in the 2016/2017 season.

Solicit and arrange on ice helpers from various divisions to act as mentors to the participants

Arrange registration and fee collection to be submitted to RAB and RDR Treasurer

Act as an ambassador for RD Ringette and explain current programs and team structures to parents with questions.

Manage rings, sticks and jerseys for participants to use for the 8 sessions.

Work with RAB to provide an end of session reward in alignment with the Ringette ABC program

Report back to the Executive on the progress of the program
