BC HOCKEY NEWS

BC HOCKEY HAS ANNOUNCED THAT THE ZONE PROGRAM PILOT PROJECT WILL BE EXTENDED FOR THE 2018-2019 SEASON.

THE FOLLOWING DISTRICT APPLICATIONS HAVE BEEN APPROVED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ZONE PROGRAM PILOT PROJECT FOR THE 2018-2019 SEASON:

- EAST KOOTENAY
- WEST KOOTENAY
- NORTH CENTRAL
- NORTH WEST
- OKANAGAN-MAINLINE (OMAHA)
- Yukon

FURTHER DETAILS WILL BE PROVIDED IN EARLY MARCH ON PROGRAM ENHANCEMENTS AND EVALUATION PROCESS. THE PROGRAM, WHICH IS ENTERING ITS THIRD SEASON, WAS DEVELOPED TO ALLOW PLAYERS TO PLAY AT THE HIGHEST LEVEL AND ALLOWS DISTRICTS TO PROVIDE REGIONAL TEAMS AND PULL FROM A GREATER DRAW ZONE.

BC HOCKEY HAS ANNOUNCED THAT BEGINNING IN THE 2018-2019 SEASON, IT WILL OPERATE A MINOR MIDGET LEAGUE FOR 15 YEAR-OLD PLAYERS STARTING WITH THE 2003 BIRTH YEAR.

The Minor Midget League gives an opportunity for 15 year-old players to develop with other athletes of the same age. The program will align with the BC Major Midget League (MML). The MML will still allow 15 year-old players should that player wish to try out for an MML team. Further details will be provided in early March about the evaluation process and program.
