Player Placement Decisions:

- All Assessments handed to SPDSA Staff after each session is completed.
- SPDSA staff will preside & facilitate post session meetings.
- Assessments are scored & compiled based upon the above criteria
- Open discussion of players begins and players start to be identified & sorted
- Final decisions on player selection and placement are made by the SPDSA Technical Department,
 Coaches and Assessors

Communications:

• Players will continue to attend tryouts as they progress unless otherwise communicated.

•Upon completion of the process, selected or placed players are contacted by the team coaches. At that time the coach may explain the seasonal plan and the commitment level required.

• Players not placed on a Tier 1 or Tier 2 team will be advised via email to attend Tier 3 assessments.

4

• Players not placed on a Tier 3 team will receive an e-mail stating that the player has the option to be placed in the SPDSA Community program. Players will need to confirm they would like to play in the Community program or they will be deleted from the registration system

Participant Definitions:

Open Assessment – Any player is able to attend Open Assessments at their appropriate age level. Decisions are based upon a Pre-Sort discussion from the SPDSA Technical Staff, Assessors and Coaches based on compiled Assessments and Historical Data. Players not selected, will be asked to attend Tier 3 Trials.

Tier 3 Assessment— Players that do not make a Tier 1 or 2 team will be asked to attend the Tier 3 Assessment. After this Assessment selected players will be invited to be part of a Tier 3 team and remainder will asked if they wish to play in the SPDSA Tier 4 Program.
