Taber enjoys warm summers and mild winters. Located in between Lethbridge and Medicine Hat, Taber residents and agriculture businesses enjoy some of the highest sunlight hours found anywhere in Canada! The Town of Taber has numerous parks located throughout the Town including: Confederation Park, Heritage Park, Prairie Lake Park and Westview Lake. Confederation Park is always bustling with activity in the summer months in the heart of downtown with a new spray park, baseball diamonds as well as a professionally designed skate park.



Festivals held throughout the year attract visitors from all across Canada to Taber. Taber's famous annual Cornfest is the main attraction of the summer and is a fantastic display of what Taber is all about. The Taber Pheasant Festival, Molnar Pumpkin Festival, Midnight Madness and Canada Day celebrations are just some of the other events held in the Town annually.



The Taber Aquafun Centre is also a staple of the community boasting a lap pool, leisure pool, children's play lagoon, hot tub, sauna, steam room as well a diving board. The Taber Community Centre has 2 ice arenas, a curling rink, health club and 600 seat auditorium. The Taber Golf Club is an 18 hole course designed for a fun challenge for all skill levels and is conveniently located next to downtown.



Just outside of the Town there are a variety of excellent campgrounds including the Municipal District of Taber Campground, Enchant Municipal Park, Grand Forks Park & Campground and the Vauxhall Lions Campground.



Taber is known for high quality sport tourism amenities including a brand new gun range, motocross track, hunting sites, numerous golf courses in the area, and some of the best fishing spots in Southern Alberta! The newly developed Trout Pond is a must visit and the Grand Forks park is home to the Sturgeon spawning grounds.
