

Pee Wee House League Tournament, May 25-27th, 2018

Pee Wee Tournament Rules:

- Games are scheduled for 2 hour maximum, no new innings after 1.5 hours of playing time. If game is not completed at 2 hour time limit and a full inning is not complete, score reverts back to last full inning (no ½ inning games)
- Please arrive 30 minutes early and have lineups exchanged with other team at least 15 minutes prior to start time
- The home team will be determined by coin toss. Balls will be supplied by the tournament.
- There will be no infield taken. All teams must be ready to play at start time.
- A pitcher can only pitch a maximum of 2 innings or a total 54 pitches per game (Baseball AB Medium pitch count)

- Once a new pitcher has taken the mound no previous pitchers are allowed to return to the mound in the same game, regardless of pitch count.
- Players can catch and then pitch, once pitched they cannot catch for the rest of the day.
- No stealing home on passed ball @ home plate, overthrows in the field are still in play & runners can advance home.
- <u>Three outs or five runs</u> shall complete a half inning except in the **playoffs** where **teams need to identify the last inning** (based on time restrictions above), which **will be open with no maximum runs**.
- If a game is tied the teams will play extra innings until a clear winner is determined. The extra inning will be based on International rules, the last 2 outs from the previous inning will be runners at 1st and 2nd base to start the inning.
- Any game except the finals, stopped due to rain will be considered complete if <u>3</u> innings have been completed. The team ahead after the 3 complete innings will be considered the winner.
- <u>Winning team</u> is responsible for completing the game sheet including; team names/#s, final score and pitchers' names (first and last, including # of innings pitched) for BOTH teams.
 Game sheet must be signed by both coaches & ump(s) and turned into the concession after the game.

MVP / Heart & Hustle Awards

 After every game each team will be responsible for choosing their teams MVP / Heart & Hustle award winners. MVP = Most Valuable Player / Heart & Hustle = The player who demonstrates great sportsmanship, teamwork and effort regardless of how great their skills are. We encourage teams to provide suggestions for the opposing team's MVP / H & H players and each team should have a different award winner for each game.
